

ORDINANCE NO. 86-5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THAT PORTION OF THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 78-3

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

Section 1: That Section 13-202 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code entitled "Sewer Connection Charge" is hereby repealed by striking all of its provisions and substituting in its place the following:

13-202. Sewer Connection Charge.

(1) Connection of one (1) family dwelling units: There is hereby imposed a charge of \$500 for each connection made to the sanitary sewer system for each single family dwelling unit.


(2) Connections for other than single family units: A connection fee for other than single family dwelling units shall be charged for each family unit contained therein. The charge for a residential building commonly referred to as a duplex shall be One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each family unit. All other residential structures shall likewise be charged Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each family unit. Hotels, motels and other establishments customarily occupied on a temporary basis shall be charged Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each separate room or suite of rooms customarily used for night time lodging and billed on a daily or other periodic basis and for each office, restaurant and room provided for meetings.

(3) All other buildings: In every other building connected to the Spring Hill Sanitary Sewer System there shall be a charge of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each unit occupied by a different business or other entity.

(4) Collection of Fees: The fees imposed hereby shall be collected before the issuance of any permit for connection to the sewer system of the Town of Spring Hill.

(5) Wastewater Rehabilitation and Extension Account:
All funds collected through these connection charges shall be placed in a new account to be known as Wastewater Rehabilitation and Extension Account. All funds in said account shall be used solely for extending sewer lines, rehabilitating existing lines, replacing existing lines with larger capacity lines, or adding to the capacity of the Wastewater Treatment Facilities of the Town of Spring Hill.


