

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, it appears to Board of Mayor and Aldermen of
the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring
Hill and the territory hereinafter described which is proposed to
be annexed by this Ordinance will be materially retarded and the
safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property thereof endan-
gered unless this territory is annexed to the corporate limits of
the Town of Spring Hill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL that the following des-
cribed area be annexed to and become a part of the corporate
limits of the Town of Spring Hill, to-wit:

An area lying on the East side of U. S. Highway 31 and
on the North side of Greens Mill Road, which is des-
cribed as follows: Beginning at a point at the inter-
section of Greens Mill Road and U. S. Highway 31, run-
ning thence generally East with the North margin of
Greens Mill Road to a point which is 1,000 feet East of
the East margin of U. S. Highway 31 and running thence
on a line which is 1,000 feet East of and parallel to
U. S. Highway 31 generally North to a point in the
South boundary line of the Middle Tennessee Agricul-
tural Experiment Station property and running thence
with its South boundary generally West to the East mar-
gin of U. S. Highway 31; thence with the East margin of
U. S. Highway 31 generally North to the present city
limits; thence, with the present city limits generally
West to the West margin of U. S. Highway 31; thence
with the West margin of U. S. Highway 31 generally
South to a point West of its intersection with the
Greens Mill Road; thence East across U. S. Highway 31
to the point of beginning.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deem the annexation of the above described property to be necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the area annexed hereby as well as the municipality as a whole.

This Ordinance was passed on third reading after a public hearing was held on October 21, 1985 upon the question of this annexation after notice thereof was duly published in the Daily Herald of Columbia, Tennessee, on October 11 and 13, 1985.

This Ordinance was further adopted after the adoption of a Plan of Services for certain areas proposed to be annexed in conformity with and as provided by Section 6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become operative thirty (30) days after the final passage thereof.


