

ORDINANCE NO. 80-7

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF BEER  
FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION FROM 12:00 NOON  
ON SUNDAY UNTIL 11:59 P.M. ON SUNDAY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN  
OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

Section 1: That pursuant to Section 57-5-301 of the  
Tennessee Code Annotated, the sale of beer of alcoholic content  
of not more than five percent (5%) by weight or other beverages  
of like alcoholic content from 12:00 Noon each Sunday until 11:59  
P.M. each Sunday for off-premises consumption is hereby authorized.

Section 2: All beverages sold under this Ordinance shall  
be sold in closed containers in the manner commonly referred to as  
package sales.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful to consume beer or other  
beverages of like alcoholic content on Sunday at any place where the  
sale of beer is authorized under the provisions of this Ordinance.
