

ORDINANCE NO. 79-9

AN ORDINANCE REESTABLISHING A SEWER CONNECTION
CHARGE AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 13 OF
THE SPRING HILL MUNICIPAL CODE ACCORDINGLY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 78-3 of the Town of Spring Hill, which was passed on third reading on April 16, 1979, established a sewer user charge schedule and imposed a fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each connection made to the sanitary sewer system to be maintained by the Town of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, some confusion has arisen as to whether or not Ordinance No. 79-7, the same being an Ordinance establishing new criteria for the use of the wastewater system and an industrial cost recovery system of the Town of Spring Hill, for Maury County, Tennessee, which was passed on third reading on the 31st day of January, 1980, repealed this connection fee; and

WHEREAS, it was not the intention of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill to repeal the sewer connection charge;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. There is hereby reimposed a charge of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each connection made to the sanitary sewer system maintained by the Town of Spring Hill until June 3, 1980.

Section 2. After June 3, 1980, the sewer connection charge will be the amount as established by a vote of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill and the cost to the Town of Spring Hill of connecting each building to the sewer system.

Section 3. That Chapter 2 of Title 13 of the Spring Hill Municipal Code be accordingly amended.
