

WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT WITH
HILLSBORO, BURWOOD & THOMPSON STATION UTILITY DISTRICT

RESOLUTION

81-1

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring Hill has a contract with the City of Columbia, Tennessee, to purchase water at a rate not to exceed 500 gallons per minute and a contract with the Hillsboro, Burwood & Thompson Station Utility District to sell water at a demand rate not to exceed 250 gallons per minute and,

WHEREAS, for the town to continue to supply the demand rate it will be necessary to make major improvements to the town water system, including a water pumping station, reservoir and distribution lines and,

WHEREAS, such improvements will require a rate increase to all customers within the city, plus the utility district now therefore,

It is resolved to enter into a forty (40) year contract with the district for \$5100.00 per month for the first 7,500,000 gallons (\$.68 per thousand gallons) and \$.62 per thousand gallons for the next 3,450,000 gallons. It is further resolved that the district may purchase additional water beyond the 10,950,000 gallons per month at a rate of \$.64 per thousand gallons, if the town has such additional water available, and the mayor of Spring Hill is authorized to execute such a contract, the same of which will meet with the approval of the Farmer's Home Administration.
