R E S O L U T I O N


WHEREAS, the Town of Spring Hill has received requests from a majority of the residents and property owners of certain territories requesting that these areas be annexed to the Town of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the prosperity of the Town of Spring Hill and the territories for which there have been requests for annexation and portions of U. S. Highway 31 will be materially retarded and the safety and welfare of the inhabitants and property endangered unless the property is annexed and that such annexation is necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the affected territory as well as the Town of Spring Hill as a whole;

NOW, THEREFORE, as provided in Section 6-51-102(b) of Tennessee Code Annotated, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby proposes the annexation of the territories set forth in the attached Second and Third March 1986 Proposed Plans of Services, which are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these Plans of Services set forth therein are hereby proposed by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen and the same are hereby submitted to the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission for study and written report to this Board within ninety (90) days from this date.


