


RESOLUTION 86-18

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING, TENNESSEE, that the Town of Spring Hill does hereby release, relinquish and surrender whatever right, title, interest or estate it may have in areas designated as streets in two proposed subdivisions which appear of record in Book 118, Page 324, and Book 124, Page 523 of the Register's Office of Maury County, Tennessee, these plats having been filed in that office on April 23, 1909, and August 21, 1914, respectively.

It is the intention of this Resolution to acknowledge the revocation of the offer to dedicate the streets to public use by the lapse of time, the nonuser by the public or the Town of Spring Hill and the fact that all of the property which the streets would serve is now owned by the person requesting this Resolution. This Resolution may be deemed as evidence of the rejection by the Town of Spring Hill of the offer to dedicate the areas as public streets.


