


RESOLUTION NUMBER 87-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID FIRE ASSISTANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, TENNESSEE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That pursuant to Section 12-9-108 and the other pertinent provisions of Part 1 of Chapter 9 of Title 12 of Tennessee Code Annotated, the Mayor of the Town of Spring Hill is authorized and empowered to enter into a mutual aid fire assistant agreement on behalf of the Town of Spring Hill with the City of Columbia, Tennessee. He is further authorized to execute any and all agreements to effectuate a mutual aid fire assistant agreement with the City of Columbia.


