

RESOLUTION NO. 87-15

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 87-14, this Board, under the authority of 6-1-301 of Tennessee Code Annotated, has requested the Maury County Election Commission to conduct an election on the question of whether or not to adopt a charter under the general laws of the State of Tennessee, which, under the provisions of Section 2-3-204 of said Code, must be held not less than forty-five (45) nor more than sixty (60) days after the Commission is directed to hold the election; and

WHEREAS, a Petition requesting an election on the question of whether or not to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises in the Town of Spring Hill has or will soon be filed with the Maury County Election Commission.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby request and direct that the election on the question of the consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises be held on the same date as the election on whether or not to adopt a charter under the general laws of the State of Tennessee, as provided in Section 57-4-103(a) as recently amended.

This Board recognizes that it will be an obligation of the Town of Spring Hill to pay all of the costs and expenses incurred by the Election Commission in conducting the election on these questions.


