

RESOLUTION NO. 88-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF THE
SEWER EASEMENT ON THE JENKINS-TERRELL TRACT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE:

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a portion of the Spring
Hill sewer line near the Kedron Pike be relocated because of the
construction of Saturn Parkway; and


WHEREAS, Peter Jenkins and Barbara Jenkins have agreed
to grant the easement sixty (6) feet in length required for this
purpose across a portion of their property at no cost but have
requested the Town of Spring Hill to release its interest in the
existing sewer easement also sixty (60) feet in length that will
be abandoned because of the relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen feels that
this is a reasonable request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR
AND ALDERMEN that the southernmost sixty (60) feet of the present
sewer easement on the Jenkins-Terrell tract be abandoned in
consideration of Peter Jenkins and Barbara Jenkins granting to
the Town of Spring Hill an additional easement sixty (60) feet in
length for the relocated sewer line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the execution of the
instrument effecting this abandonment by the Mayor and Recorder
is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.
