A RESOLUTION NAMING THE COMMUNITY ROOM IN THE NEW CITY HALL  
IN HONOR OF GEORGE C. JONES

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill meets tonight at a regular session as it has done for the last 150 years. Tonight, however, is the third regular meeting in the new Spring Hill City Hall and is five (5) days before the Grand Opening of this building. The Board deems it appropriate that the Minutes reflect this occasion.

The Board of Aldermen hereby officially acknowledges that this building is the direct result of the efforts of its Mayor, George C. Jones, as it was constructed entirely with funds which are a part of Spring Hill's portion of the Saturn In Lieu Of Tax Payments to the County as negotiated by the Mayor and it is constructed on property donated at no cost to Spring Hill by the Developers of the Town Center.

The Board at this time acknowledges the many deeds of George C. Jones for the benefit of the people of Spring Hill, both as a private citizen, as a member of this Board and during his two terms as Mayor, many of which activities are known only to the people who benefited by them.

In consideration of all of the foregoing, the Board of Aldermen does hereby resolve that the Community Room in the City Hall be known as the George C. Jones Community Room.
