

RESOLUTION NO. 88-11

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE OBSERVANCE OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. HOLIDAY ON THE THIRD MONDAY OF JANUARY OF EACH YEAR.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee has established the third Monday in January of each year as a legal holiday in honor of the late Martin Luther King, Jr., known as Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday by Chapter No. 979 of the Public Acts of 1984; and


WHEREAS, the State Legislature has further by Joint Resolution No. 462 of the 1988 General Assembly formally requested each municipality to proclaim Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday on the third Monday of January of each year; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting for the nation, the State of Tennessee, and the Town of Spring Hill, to observe Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday, by encouraging appropriate reflection on his life, his commitment to the causes of social justice, equality, and human dignity, and his contributions to the nation.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, that the third Monday of January of each year is hereby designated a municipal legal holiday, known as Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday.


