

RESOLUTION NO. 89-17

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PLAN OF SERVICES
FOR THE HOOTEN PROPERTY ON THE OLD KEDRON PIKE

WHEREAS, by a resolution (No. 89-14) adopted on the 14th day of August, 1989, a Plan of Services was proposed for the Hooten property located on the Old Kedron Pike; and

WHEREAS, by that resolution this Plan of Services was submitted to the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission for study and written reports; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on August 14, 1989, a study was conducted on this proposed Plan of Services and it was unanimously approved by this Commission which submitted its written report to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a resolution (No. 89-16) adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen at a meeting held on August 21, 1989, the Recorder and City Attorney were instructed to give notice of public hearings to be held on this proposed Plan of Services and the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, this notice was duly published in the Spring Hill Morning Sun, giving notice of the public hearings to be held at 6:50 p.m. and 6:55 p.m. on Monday, August 18, 1989, at the Spring Hill City Hall on the proposed Plan of Services and the proposed annexation, respectively; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this notice a public hearing was held before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen at 6:50 p.m. on September 18, 1989, on the Proposed Plan of Services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has considered the matters raised at the public hearing and has determined that the proposed Plan of Services submitted to the Planning Commission on August 14, 1989, should be and the same is hereby adopted.
