


A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MAURY COUNTY
ELECTION COMMISSION TO CONDUCT AN
ELECTION WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL ON APRIL 14, 1994,
TO ELECT ONE ALDERMEN FROM EACH OF THE FOUR WARDS
PURSUANT TO THE ELECTION LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

That the Maury County Election Commission be authorized
and requested to conduct a regular municipal election for the Town
of Spring Hill on Saturday, May 14, 1994, for the purpose of
electing one Aldermen from each of the four wards, each for a term
of two years and eleven months (from May 16, 1994, until the third
Monday of April 1997).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby
authorized to request the Maury County Election Commission to hold
the election, the cost of which will, by law, be borne by the Town
of Spring Hill.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on
this the 21st day of February, 1994.


