

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE SENATOR
AND THE STATE REPRESENTATIVES REPRESENTING
THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL TO INTRODUCE AND SECURE
PASSAGE OF AN ACT OF THE TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
AS EARLY IN THE YEAR 1995 AS POSSIBLE
ALLOWING PERSONS RESIDING OUTSIDE OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL, BUT OWNING PROPERTY WITHIN
ITS CORPORATE LIMITS, TO VOTE IN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF SPRING HILL:

THAT the State Representatives and State Senator
representing the Town of Spring Hill in the Tennessee General
Assembly are hereby requested to introduce and secure passage of an
act in the 1995 Tennessee General Assembly allowing persons living
outside the city limits of Spring Hill but owning property inside
the corporate limits to vote in municipal elections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these members of the General
Assembly are requested to secure passage of this act at the
earliest possible date as the next municipal election will be held
in April of 1995.
