**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE TAKE-HOME USE OF CITY-OWNED VEHICLES AND TO SPECIFY THE POSITIONS FOR WHICH THE AUTHORIZATION APPLIES**

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to designate specific positions that individuals occupy that are authorized the use of take-home vehicles; and


**WHEREAS**, the intent of this resolution is to clearly establish the need and the authority for such use, and to establish a more economical system of fleet management

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, that the following employment positions and the individuals occupying those positions are hereby authorized to drive their city-owned vehicles to and from their place of residence to work;


1. Police Chief
2. Assistant Police Chief
3. Lieutenant – Patrol Division
4. Lieutenant – COPS Program and Investigations
5. Fire Chief
6. Superintendent – Wastewater
7. Superintendent – Water
8. Superintendent – Streets

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all other city-owned vehicles be parked in the appropriate location at the end of each workday and that this policy shall take effect upon the date of adoption of this resolution.
