

**RESOLUTION 99-47**

**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO REQUESTING A PUBLIC ACT OF  
THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MODIFYING T.C.A. SECTION 6-53-102**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to request from the General Assembly a public a public act amending T.C.A. Section 6-53-102 permitting the Town of Spring Hill to modify, amend and revise its Charter to permit certain nonresident taxpayers to vote in municipal elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to request of State Senator Marsha Blackburn, State Representative Bobby Sands and State Representative Mike Williams the introduction of a bill to enact a public act amending T.C.A. Section 6-53-102 as follows:

(f)(1) In any city with a population of not less than one thousand four hundred (1,400) nor more than one thousand five hundred (1,500) according to the 1990 federal census all persons residing outside the corporation limits of such city who shall have owned not less than a one-half (1/2) interest in a taxable freehold, in land, or a husband and wife who shall have owned a taxable freehold in land as tenants by the entireties within the corporation for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the date of such election, and being otherwise qualified, shall also be entitled to vote as such election.
