
A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE DEVELOPMENT OF A PROPOSAL TO GRANT SOME RELIEF FROM SEWER CHARGES FOR THE SUMMERTIME USE OF WATER IN WATERING LAWNS AND GARDENS, THE WASHING OF VEHICLES AND OTHER USES OF WATER THAT DOES NOT ENTER THE SEWER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, there is a need to grant some monetary relief to customers of the Town's sewer system for use of water that does not enter the Town's sewer system for treatment; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be a rate proposal developed, and approved by the State, that will grant some monetary relief to customers while maintaining the system in a sound financial condition

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to develop such a sewer rate proposal, obtain State approval, insure the system's financial stability will be maintained and present the proposal to the Board for consideration and adoption at the June 21, 1999 meeting.
