

**RESOLUTION 99-17**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF AN  
ADDITIONAL ELEMENT TO THE TOWN'S WATER SYSTEM  
TELEMETRY NETWORK TO CONTROL OUTPUT OF TWO WATER  
BOOSTER PUMP STATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town's Water System currently has two (2) water booster pump stations in operation at two (2) separate locations; and

**WHEREAS**, growth demand on the system is requiring that the run-time on those two (2) pump stations be better coordinated and synchronized; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town's Telemetry System can easily handle the coordination with the installation of an additional element at both stations

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, that the proposal of Dexter-Fortson, as the sole source supplier of this equipment, be accepted to install the equipment at a cost of seven thousand one hundred and two (\$7,102.00) dollars and this installation to occur immediately after adoption of this Resolution
