

**RESOLUTION 99-41**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A PLAN OF SERVICES FOR MAURY COUNTY PROPERTY AS LISTED IN ORDINANCE 99-24, AND KNOWN AS ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF PORT ROYAL ROAD, KEDRON ROAD, DERRYBERRY ROAD AND TOM LUNN ROAD AND IS CONTIGUOUS TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, proposes the following plan of services for the road known as road rights-of-way of Port Royal Road, Kedron Road, Derryberry Road and Tom Lunn Road and as annexed by Ordinance 99-24.

1. Police and Fire Protection: Police and Fire protection will be provided immediately upon the effective date of annexation.
2. Public Water Service: Not applicable.
3. Public Sewer Service: Not applicable.
4. Solid Waste Disposal: Not applicable.
5. Recreational Facilities: Not applicable.
6. Planning & Zoning Services: Not applicable.
7. Road and Street Construction & Repair: The Town will provide maintenance services on streets and roads and rights-of-way of streets and roads being annexed.
8. All other services of the Town: All other services offered by the Town will be offered according to general policy of the Town.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, this plan of services was recommended for adoption by the Spring Hill Regional Planning Commission on November 8, 1999, and was published in "The Car Country News" on November 9, 1999. A public hearing held before the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on November 15, 1999.
