A RESOLUTION TO URGE THE
HIERARCHY OF THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH
TO REFRAIN FROM MOVING THE CHURCH
OR CONGREGATION OF THE GRACE EPISCOPAL CHURCH
FROM ITS' PRESENT LOCATION IN SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE

Whereas, the Grace Episcopal Church of Spring Hill, Tennessee has been in its' present location since construction on or about the year 1876, and

Whereas, the structure has been listed on the National Historic Register since 1976, and

Whereas, the loss of this historic church would be a serious loss to the Town of Spring Hill, being one of the oldest structures in old Spring Hill


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that a request be made to the Episcopal Bishop of Tennessee not to consider moving the structure or congregation of the Grace Episcopal Church of Spring Hill now located at the intersection of Beechcroft and Main Streets.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 18th day of May, 1998.


