**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT  
WITH NALLS DOZER AND BACKHOE, FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE,  
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER LINE ALONG A PORTION OF MAIN  
STREET FROM THE FARMERS CO-OP TO THE EDGE OF MCKEES FLORIST SHOP  
FOR THE SUM OF \$12,224, WITH FUNDS  
TO BE DRAWN FROM WATER TAP FEES**


Whereas, a section of the water line of the Spring Hill system along Main Street had deteriorated due to age, and

Whereas, this line has given constant trouble in recent years occasioning numerous after hours dig and repair operations, and

Whereas, the project was properly designed, advertised and bid and Nalls Dozer and Backhoe, Franklin, Tennessee, was the low and recommended bidder


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Nalls Dozer and Backhoe (A.J. Nalls), Franklin, Tennessee, for the replacement with new construction of a water line on Main Street according to plans and specifications prepared by the Town's engineer for the sum of \$12,224, funds are to be drawn from water taps, but further that the portion of the water line fronting the Parman Oil Company is not to be included in this agreement but shall be installed by the Parman Oil Company while constructing their new Par-Mart outlet.**

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 20th day of April, 1998.




