
A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT
WITH MAURY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT
FOR DISPATCH SERVICES FOR THE SUM
OF \$2,666.66 PER MONTH
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM
THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT BUDGETS IN FY 99

Whereas, the governing Board has determined, based upon an increase in price and continuing poor service to the Spring Hill police department by the dispatch service of the Maury County Sheriff's department that a change in serving agencies is desirable, and

Whereas, the original intent of agencies in Maury County in forming the Maury Emergency Communications District was to have a unified and jointly funded dispatch service and it has become timely to enter into an agreement,


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Maury Emergency Communications District, 1010 Galloway Street, Columbia, Tennessee, for dispatch services for the police and fire departments for the sum of \$2,666.66 per month, funds are to be drawn from police and fire budgets, in a ratio as determined by the governing Board, at the budget hearings for FY 99, further that this agreement shall not be executed until the police department receives FCC approval for a separate radio frequency for the exclusive use of the Spring Hill police department.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 20th day of April, 1998.


