

RESOLUTION No. 98-33

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH MAURY FENCE COMPANY, COLUMBIA, TENNESSEE
FOR FENCING AT THE CITY PARK FOR THE SUM OF \$5,895
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM
THE CAPITOL PROJECTS ACCOUNT, FISCAL YEAR 1998,
OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

Whereas, the southern perimeter of the city park is unsecured resulting in unauthorized penetration of the park during periods of time when no adult supervision is present, and

Whereas, such off hours trespassing into the city park has resulted in vandalism, theft and other forms of youthful mischief and, in addition, holds the potential for injury of minors, and

Whereas, a secure chain link fence with a barbed wire topping and locked gate can mitigate problems in the park, and

Whereas, requests for bids were publicly advertised and received on May 11, 1998 and Maury Fence Company, Columbia, Tennessee was the low bidder

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Maury Fence Company, Columbia, Tennessee, for fencing the south boundary of city park according directions given them by the public works superintendent, for the sum of \$5,895.00, with funds to be drawn from the capitol project account of the fiscal year 1999 parks and recreation department budget.
