A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT  
WITH MAURY COUNTY AND THE MAURY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD  
TO CONSTRUCT A REAR ENTRY ROAD  
INTO SPRING HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL  
WITH FUNDING OF MATERIALS BY SPRING HILL  
TO BE EXCHANGED FOR  
A GRANT OF A BUILDING LOT BY MAURY COUNTY

Whereas, after much study, a common understanding has emerged by Maury County Commissioners, Maury County School Board and the governing Board of Spring Hill concerning the best way to handle traffic congestion at Spring Hill Elementary School, and

Whereas, an offer has been made by the Maury County School Board and Maury County Commission to have the Maury County road superintendent do the necessary work for a rear entry road if Spring Hill will fund the materials cost, and

Whereas, in return for funding of material cost, Maury County will grant to the Town of Spring Hill a lot, said lot fronts on Maury Hill Street and is now owned by Maury County, with the provision that Spring Hill will auction off said lot and return same to the tax rolls, and

Whereas, the governing Board has decided this is a prudent arrangement which will relieve congestion on Main Street

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into agreements with the Maury County Commission to fund the materials cost of a rear entry road into Spring Hill Elementary School with construction to be done by the County road superintendent and conditioned further on the grant to the Town of a lot owned by Maury County, said lot fronts on Maury Hill Street and further, that funds for purchase of materials shall be taken from the capitol outlay of the Streets budget for Fiscal Year 1999, such capitol outlay fund depletion to be replenished by sale of the lot at public auction

**Whereas**, a tentative offer has been made by the Maury County School Board and Maury County Commission to have the Maury County road superintendent do the necessary work for a rear entry road if Spring Hill will fund the materials cost, and

**Whereas**, in return for funding of material cost, Maury County will grant to the Town of Spring Hill a lot owned by Maury County, said lot fronts on Maury Hill Street and is adjacent to the school grounds, and

**Whereas**, the governing Board has decided this is a prudent arrangement which will relieve congestion on Main Street

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill** that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into agreements with the Maury County Commission and Maury County School Board to fund the materials cost of a rear entry road into Spring Hill Elementary School and conditioned further on the assumption that Maury County will grant to the Town a lot owned by Maury County, said lot fronts on Maury Hill Street and further, that funds for purchase of materials shall be taken from the capitol outlay of the Streets budget for Fiscal Year 1999
