

RESOLUTION No. 98-43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF SPRING HILL  
TO SPEND A SUM OF MONIES NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000  
AT HIS DISCRETION TO IN AN INDUSTRIAL RECRUITING EFFORT IN ORDER  
TO ACHIEVE AN INDUSTRIAL BASE INDUSTRY FOR SPRING HILL

Whereas, it behooves the governing Board of Spring Hill to make efforts to broaden the industrial base of the Town so that a down turn in the business fortunes of The Saturn Corporation shall not ruin the economy of Spring Hill, and

Whereas, the nature of industrial recruiting, especially in the recruitment of large base industries, has to be very secretive at the request of the prospective clients, and

Whereas, the Mayor needs flexibility and freedom to negotiate with such prospective clients without the necessity of revealing all information on a continuing basis

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor is authorized, empowered and directed to pursue the larger industrial clients and to spend up to \$15,000, at his discretion, to cover necessary costs involved in recruiting, studies, analysis, advertisement or other necessary expenditures as may be required to gain a reasonable possibility of achieving these goals and further, that these expended funds shall be taken from the general fund.
