

RESOLUTION No. 98-48

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE EFFORTS
OF MAURY AND LAWRENCE COUNTY OFFICIALS
IN THEIR EFFORTS TO PERSUADE THE STATE OF TENNESSEE
TO DO IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. HIGHWAY 412

Whereas, U.S. Highway 412 is usually the route chosen by Maury Countians traveling to Jackson, Memphis and other parts of West Tennessee, and

Whereas, U.S. 412 is the route which Lewis Countians use to travel to jobs in Maury County and to patronize our hospitals, certain churches and local businesses, and

Whereas, the traffic on U.S. 412 has increased remarkably during the past few years and significant portions of adjoining lands have been developed for commercial and residential purposes so that lower speed limits have been put in effect, and

Whereas, students at Columbia State from Lewis County and other counties west of Lewis use that highway traveling to and from the school, and

Whereas, the Maury Regional Hospital Ambulance Service has to use 412 several times a day transporting patients to Columbia and Nashville and 15 or 20 minutes saved could also save a life, and

Whereas, this two lane highway is no longer adequate to handle the traffic in a safe and efficient manner, especially during periods when the road is wet or icy, and

Whereas, the proposal for improvement by creating a four lane highway to connect with the highway between Columbia and Lawrenceburg will significantly reduce the time required to travel between Columbia and Hohenwald and will provide a much safer and more efficient route

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that they fully support the improvement of U.S. Highway 412 by making it a four lane highway and following the route depicted on the map attached to this resolution.

Be it further resolved that the Mayor be authorized and instructed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Lt. Governor, Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Transportation, Senator Keith Jordan, Senator Pete Springer, Representative Bobby Sands and Representative Joe Fowlkes
