OF THE BUILDING AND CODES DEPARTMENT 1999 BUDGET


Whereas, the building and codes department has been using a retired police car in lieu of a truck with such used police cruiser is now approaching the end of its' useful life, and

Whereas, codes inspectors actually need a truck to move into construction sites needing their surveillance and inspection, and

Whereas, public request for bids was made and four (4) bids were received with Sloan Ford Lincoln Mercury, Inc., 115 South James Campbell Blvd, Columbia, Tennessee, being the lowest and best bid

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the building and codes department is is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for the purchase of a 1998 extended cab Ford F-150 truck from Sloan Lincoln Mercury Ford Inc., Columbia, Tennessee, for the sum of \$16,923.00 with funds to be drawn from capitol outlay funds of the FY 1999 codes department budget as set aside for the purchase of a truck.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 21st day of September, 1998.




