

RESOLUTION No. 98-63

A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE FOUR (4) VIDEO CAMERAS
FROM KUSTOM SIGNALS, INC.
FOR THE SUM OF \$25,084.00
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM CAPITOL OUTLAY ACCOUNT
OF THE FY 1999 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET

Whereas, the Spring Hill police patrol division is lacking in video camera recorders in 8 patrol division cruisers of 10 in service with particular emphasis on the cruisers usually used in night patrol duty, and

Whereas, in the interests of protecting both the officers from false accusations and the public from misconduct by police officers, and

Whereas, video cameras are used for the recording and retention of evidence thereby enhancing prosecution, and

Whereas, it is the intent of the department to eventually have patrol cruisers equipped with video cameras and four (4) were budgeted in FY 99 in order to gradually accomplishment this purpose, and

Whereas, request for bids was publicly advertised and bids were received and opened on October 15, 1998, and Kustom Signals, Inc, was found to be to be the best and lowest bidder

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the police chief is authorized to purchase four (4) video camera recorders from Kustom Signals, Inc., for the sum of \$25,084.00 with funds to be drawn from capitol outlay account of the police department as budgeted in the FY 1999 Town budget.
