

RESOLUTION No. 98-68

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH
NALLS UTILITY AND CONSTRUCTION, FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF A TEMPORARY FORCE MAIN
AND RELOCATION OF A DUPLEX PUMP AND ASSOCIATED WORK
FOR THE SUM OF \$9,282.00 WITH FUNDS
TO BE DRAWN FROM SEWER RESERVE CAPACITY FEES

Whereas, an agreement is in force between Trianon Development (Wyngate subdivision developers) and the Town of Spring Hill wherein Trianon will payback \$100,000 of sewer line cost in addition to all ordinary fees but must have temporary service as a condition of this agreement, and

Whereas, it is determined that the most economical means of temporary service is the construction of 900 feet, more or less, of small temporary force main and the relocation and use of a surplus town owned duplex lift pump, and

Whereas, there was a public request for bids, bids were received on November 13, 1998, and Nalls Utility and Construction, Franklin, Tennessee, was determined to be the low and only bid, this being a fair price and further, there being no reason why Nalls Utility and Construction can't satisfactorily perform this work

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Nalls Utility and Construction, Franklin, Tennessee, for construction of approximately 900 feet of force main and relocation of a duplex pump for the sum of \$9,282.00 with funds to be taken from retained sewer capacity reserve funds

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen on the 16th day of November, 1998.


