

RESOLUTION No. 98-70

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT  
WITH BURGIN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.,  
BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF  
A WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT FOR THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL  
FOR THE SUM OF \$4,070,750.00 WITH  
FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM A  
TDEC LOAN OF \$3,900,000.00 PLUS OTHER  
ELIGIBLE FUNDS AS THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR MAY DETERMINE

Whereas, a new waste water treatment plant (wwtp) is a State of Tennessee mandated facility for the Town of Spring Hill, and

Whereas, a request for bids was publicly advertised for construction of the new WWTP, and

Whereas, bids were received and it was determined that Construction Company, Birmingham, Alabama, was the low bidder and is recommended by the consulting engineer for award of the contract

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with Burgin Construction Company, Inc., Birmingham, Alabama, for the sum of \$4,070,750.00 for construction of a waste water treatment plant with funds to be drawn from a \$3,900,000.00 Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) loan plus other eligible funds as the city administrator may determine
