A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
FROM THE MUNICIPAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY SERVICE
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE
IN ASSESSING VARIOUS OPTIONS
FOR REVISION OF POLITICAL WARD LINES DUE
TO INCREASING AND SHIFTING POPULATION NUMBERS

Whereas, population numbers have expanded and concentrated in parts of the town not previously occupied, and

Whereas, this population increase and new concentrations of population have caused the existent political wards to become unbalanced, and

Whereas, the governing Board has chosen to study the problem and determine if action needs to be taken in correcting this imbalance in order to insure the integrity and legality of elections held in Spring Hill

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that an invitation shall be sent to the Municipal Technical Advisory Service of the University of Tennessee requesting their technical assistance in suggesting, assessing and advising the governing Board as regards the matter of revision of political ward lines in the Town of Spring Hill.
