

RESOLUTION No. 98-76

A RESOLUTION TO COMPENSATE JERRY WELLS
FOR ECONOMIC DAMAGE TO HIS FARMING OPERATION DUE
TO CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER LINE ACROSS THE WELL'S FARM
IN THE SUM OF \$3,000.00 WITH FUNDS
TO BE DRAWN FROM SEWER RESERVE CAPACITY FEES
WITH PAYMENT OF SAME
CONTINGENT UPON ACCEPTANCE OF THE TOWN'S OFFER FOR PURCHASE OF
PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY EASEMENTS

Whereas, the town is compelled to construct a sewer line across the farm belonging to the Wells family, and

Whereas, Jerry Wells, farmer, operates a cattle enterprise upon these lands, and

Whereas, this cattle operation will be economically damaged due to the construction of the line

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to compensate Jerry Wells for economic loss to his cattle farming enterprise in the sum of \$3,000.00 with funds to be drawn from sewer reserve capacity fees pending the acceptance by Jerry Wells of the monies offered by the town for purchase of a permanent and temporary easement across the Wells family property
