

**RESOLUTION No. 98-7**

**A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
WITH S AND W ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, MURFREESBORO, TENNESSEE,  
FOR THE SUM OF \$10,140.00,  
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM STREETS DEPARTMENT  
FY 98 CAPITOL OUTLAY BUDGET,  
TO CONSTRUCT FLASHING PRE-EMPTION WARNING LIGHTS  
ACROSS ONE LANE AT EACH OF THE LOCATIONS  
WHEREIN ROUTE 247 INTERSECTS  
THE CSX RAILROAD AND PORT ROYAL ROAD INTERSECTIONS**

**Whereas**, two intersections exist on State Route 247 inside the corporate boundaries of the Town of Spring Hill which are blind intersections and therefore dangerous to the public, and

**Whereas**, it has been determined by the governing Board that accidents have occurred at these locations and additional accidents will occur in the future, some of which may result in fatalities, and

**Whereas**, the most feasible measures which may be taken at the present time, until more expensive permanent solutions may be constructed, are to construct and install pre-emption warning lights across the blind approaching lane, and

**Whereas**, this project was publicly advertised, bids were received, and S and W Electrical Contractors, Murfreesboro, Tennessee, were determined to be the low bidder

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN** of the Town of Spring Hill that the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to enter into an agreement with S and W Electrical Contractors, Murfreesboro, Tennessee, for the sum of \$10,140.00, with funds to be drawn from the FY 98 Capitol Outlay budget of the streets department, for construction of pre-emption warning lights across the blind lane of State Route 247 preceding the intersection of the CSX Railroad and Port Royal Road in accordance with the bid of S and W Electrical Contractors and specifications prepared by the staff of the Town of Spring Hill.
