

**A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE "COMMUNITY DAY" TO BE  
AN ANNUAL SPECIAL EVENT SPONSORED BY TOWN GOVERNMENT  
AND TO DELEGATE THE PLANNING AND OPERATION  
OF THIS ANNUAL SPECIAL EVENT  
TO THE ROTARY CLUB OF SPRING HILL  
TO BE ADMINISTERED  
WITHIN THE GENERAL GUIDELINES OF TOWN GOVERNMENT**

**Whereas**, the first community day event, a happening created by an informal ad hoc committee of Spring Hill citizens, proved to be a resounding success, and

**Whereas**, Community Day serves to unite the community and provide an annual meeting place for community leaders, entrepreneurs, civic clubs and city departments to become acquainted or reacquainted, and

**Whereas**, the governing Board has determined this event should be formally adopted by the town as a special event and be supported by the various departments and employees of town government, and

**Whereas**, Community Day is an appropriate event to delegate to a volunteer group and the Rotary Club of Spring Hill has shown willingness to adopt such and provide the volunteerism of time and energy to plan and operate for the benefit of all the people of the town

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill**, that the annual event to be known now and hereafter as "Community Day" is hereby designated by the governing Board as a "Special Event" of town government but shall be scheduled, planned, operated and manned by the Rotary Club of Spring Hill within the general guidelines as set by the Town of Spring Hill; and further, that all departments of town government are authorized, empowered and directed to support the Rotary Club of Spring Hill in their production of the annual "Community Day".
