

RESOLUTION No. 98-77

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS
AT THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND TO ENTER
INTO AGREEMENT WITH BURGIN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.,
BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, FOR THE SUM OF \$4,231,850.00
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM A \$3,900,000.00 LOAN
FROM THE STATE OF TENNESSEE AND FROM OTHER FUNDS
AS MAY BE PROPERLY USED AND AS DETERMINED BY
THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR

Whereas, certain improvements are necessary at the wastewater treatment plant, and

Whereas, the improvements are being funded by the State Revolving Fund Loan previously obtained by the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, and

Whereas, the following bids were received concerning the proposed improvements and were opened on December 3, 1998

Whereas, Burgin Construction Company, Inc., was determined to be the better or low bidder for the proposed improvements at the wastewater treatment plant, and

Whereas, the bidding document for this project allows for the selection of the manufacturers of designated items of major equipment whereby the Town's selection of acceptable manufacturers offered by Burgin Construction Company, Inc., will result in an adjusted bid amount of \$4,016,850.00, and

Whereas, the bidding document for this project also allows for the selection of an alternate bid amount for a disk tertiary filter installation, whereby the Town's acceptance of the disk tertiary filter installation will result in an adjusted bid amount of \$4,231,850.00, and

Whereas, subsequent to the Town's acceptance of these items of major equipment and acceptance of the disk tertiary filter, Burgin Construction Company, Inc., was determined to be the better or low bidder for the proposed improvements at the wastewater treatment plant at a cost of \$4,231,850.00

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Spring Hill that:

Subject to the approval by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized, empowered and directed to execute a contract with Burgin Construction Company, Inc., Birmingham, Alabama, in the amount of \$4,231,850.00 for the additions and improvements to the wastewater treatment plant with funds to be drawn from the \$3,900,000 loan from the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation and from other water/sewer related funds as may be properly used for this purpose and as determined by the City Administrator.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and adoption, the public welfare requiring the same.
