**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen wish to provide for the safety of employees and the service to citizens; and


**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Fire Department is in need of protective jackets and pants for structural firefighting; and

**WHEREAS**, city staff advertised and received quotes for this project on February 10, 2017; and


**WHEREAS**; City staff has reviewed proposals and has made a recommendation to the Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen.


