Department Budget Status:

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- I. Purpose/Overview: To purchase equipment for new police vehicles for 2017/18 budget. Equipment was approved in this years budget.
- II. Background Information: The City of Spring Hill pre-ordered 10 Chevrolet Caprices last budget year due to the Caprice no longer being built after this year. This purchase is to outfit/equip the vehicles for patrol day to day operations. The Caprices should be delivered at any time. The budgeted 180,000.00 will outfit eight of the ten caprices, along with light bars for remaining two Caprices. The 180,000.00 budgeted was short due to not including vehicle cameras. We pre-ordered cameras for last year's vehicle, therefore, it was mistakenly left off the equipment list for this year's vehicles.
- III. Financial Impact to Budget. \$180,000.00.
- IV. Alternative Options: Have 10 unmarked Caprices with no equipment.
- V. Staff Recommendations: Purchase equipment from vendors either from State Contract or from quotes.
