

RESOLUTION NO. 96-1

**A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL CENSUS
OF THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL
FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAINING A FAIR SHARE
OF STATE OF TENNESSEE SHARED TAXES**

Whereas, it is the belief of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill that the Town has had a significant growth in its population since the 1995 State of Tennessee special census;

Whereas, up to three city wide special censuses may be conducted at any time between federal censuses per decade;

Whereas, a significant increase in population could greatly enhance the revenue resources for the Town of Spring Hill;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that a special city wide census be conducted of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, in accordance with the "Procedures for Taking Special Censuses for Population Certification" established by the Local Planning Assistance Office (LPAO) of the Tennessee Department of Economic And Community Development, with the results to be presented to the LPAO for certification.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town's budget for fiscal year 1995-96 shall be amended to include funds as needed to pay for the special census project, with fund allocation to be determined at a later date by the Board.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 15th day of January, 1996.




