A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE A CAPITAL  
EXPENDITURE OUT OF THE WATER DEPARTMENT  
CONTINGENCY FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF TELEMETRY  
EQUIPMENT FOR MONITORING THE TOWN HALL WATER TANK

Whereas, the Town of Spring Hill seeks to use technology to save labor costs and to insure the safety of public employees;


Whereas, the Town has an existing telemetry system installed to send signal information from a water pump station and tank to an in-house computer receiver in Town Hall; and

Whereas, the south side water tank located at Town Hall does not have such a signal system whereby necessary data can be electronically collected and viewed in real time.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

Capital expenditure in the sum of \$3,400 shall be used to purchase telemetry equipment for the monitoring of the Town Hall water tank, and this money will be taken from the Water Department Account No. 780 entitled "Contingency Funds".

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1996.


