

RESOLUTION 96-58

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE UNDER T.C.A. § 57-3-208, AND CONDITIONALLY APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A RETAILER'S LICENSE, FOR LINDA GEMMELL, OWNER OF PROPOSED SPRING HILL LIQUORS AT MARKET PLACE VILLAGE, 5441 MAIN STREET

Whereas, Linda Gemmell is applying to the Alcoholic Beverage Commission for the State of Tennessee for a retail liquor license to operate a business to be known as Spring Hill Liquors at Market Place Village, 5441 Main Street, Spring Hill, Tennessee;

Whereas, T.C.A. 57-3-208 requires that the applicant for license submit with the application to the Commission a certificate signed by the mayor certifying that an investigation has been undertaken of the applicant's criminal record and of the compliance of said proposed business with municipal ordinances and resolutions, and that from the investigation the Town certifies:

- a. That the applicant has not been convicted of a felony within a ten-year period immediately preceding the date of the application, and that it is the Town's opinion that the applicant does not violate any provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 3;
- b. That the applicant has secured a location which complies with the restrictions of laws, ordinances, and resolutions;
- c. That the applicant has complied with the residency requirement in Municipal Code Section 8-105, that the applicant must be, and have been, for at least two years, a citizen and resident of Maury or Williamson County, Tennessee, residing within 3 miles of the corporate limits of the Town of Spring Hill, and not a citizen, resident, or inhabitant of any other community, either incorporated or unincorporated; and
- d. That the issuance of the proposed license will not exceed the numerical limit of two retail licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquor established in Municipal Code Section 8-107.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that:

The Mayor is authorized to sign a Certificate of Compliance under T. C.A. § 57-3-208 for Linda Gemmell, applicant for a retail liquor license from the Alcoholic Beverage Commission of Tennessee.

By action of a majority of the Board, approval is granted for the issuance of a retailer's license for the applicant conditioned on the issuance of the state license and compliance with the provisions of Municipal Code Sections 8-101 through 123.
