

RESOLUTION NO. 96-62

**A RESOLUTION TO FUND THE SUM OF \$6,000 FROM
APPROPRIATED CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS IN ORDER
TO PROVIDE SURGE PROTECTION FROM LIGHTNING
STRIKES AT TOWN HALL IN ORDER TO INSURE
PROTECTION OF COMPUTER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE
AND OTHER COMPONENTS OF THE TOWN HALL BUILDING**

Whereas, there currently exists no lightning surge protection between the primary feed line transformer and Town Hall;


Whereas, past experience has indicated the need for such protection and the value of computer records and data are such that a major surge would be ruinous to Town Hall operations resulting in an effective shut down of Town government; and

Whereas, surge protection for major strikes can be contracted in the approximate sum of \$6,000.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the following resolution is adopted:


A contract will be signed by the Mayor for surge protection in Town Hall in the approximate sum of \$6,000.00 in order to gain protection from catastrophic lightning strikes, such work to take place as soon as possible and before any new computer hardware and software is purchased as a consequence of changeover to a new software vendor.
