

RESOLUTION NO. 97-1

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD GRASSY BRANCH  
INTERCEPTOR (GRASSY BRANCH #1) CONTRACT TO  
LOW BIDDER, MAINLINE CONTRACTORS, DICKSON, TENNESSEE  
FOR SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$135,396.00, WITH  
FUNDS COMING FROM SEWER AND WATER TAP FEES**

**Whereas**, there has arisen an opportunity to construct an incremental section of the Grassy Run Creek Interceptor, a primary wastewater interceptor, in partnership with three separate developments;

**Whereas**, the whole length of the Grassy Branch Interceptor will have to be constructed in the not distant future in order to relieve overload on the McCutcheon Creek Interceptor;

**Whereas**, the governing Board has decided to avail itself of all opportunities to reduce costs by gaining contribution to the system from developers and landowners, and the first Grassy Branch Interceptor contract will serve as a conceptual model for such public-private partnership agreements;

**Whereas**, the Grassy Branch Interceptor mentioned herein has been properly designed and publicly advertised and bid with Mainline Contractors, Dickson, Tennessee, being the low bidder at the bid price of \$135,396.00.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that**

The Board authorizes an agreement to be signed between the Town of Spring Hill and Mainline Contractors, Dickson, Tennessee, in a sum not to exceed \$135,396.00 for construction of the Grassy Branch Interceptor sewer line.

Funds will be taken from any or all of the following as the City Administrator may decide but in the order as listed as funds are available from each: water and sewer tap fees, water and sewer depreciation funds, sewerage system capital expansion funds and water works (operating account).
