

RESOLUTION NO. 97-2

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE HIGHERS, KOONCE AND ASSOCIATES, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, TO PERFORM ALL NECESSARY WORK TO SURVEY, DESIGN, PREPARE BID DOCUMENTS, AND BID THE BUCKNER ROAD EXTENSION PROJECT AND ASSIST IN CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION FOR THE SUM OF \$4,000, FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM WARD TWO IMPACT FEES

Whereas, the increase of population and traffic are creating ever more dangerous conditions on the country lane named Buckner Road which encircles Magli Hill as it enters U.S. Highway 31;

Whereas, the necessity of improvement by reconstruction is now accepted by the Board as inevitable although not all of the Town and Williamson County developer(s) partnering terms on reconstruction have been firmly brought to final agreement;

Whereas, certain landowners need to know exactly where the reconstruction is going to be placed so that development plans can be made final; and

Whereas, the survey, property acquisition, construction design, and working documents will need to be completed in order to achieve good estimates and perform preliminary work prior to actual construction;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that a project known as the "Extension of Buckner Road" shall be surveyed, deed descriptions prepared, and design and preparation of working documents done by Highers, Koonce and Associates, Consulting Engineers, for the sum of \$4,000, with funds to be drawn from impact fees for Ward Two.

It is acknowledged in this Resolution that the Town will initially pay the funds for this engineering work in order to achieve some early objectives of sound cost estimates and exact land acquisition descriptions, but this Resolution does not bind the Town as the final payor of the aforementioned \$4,000 (plus reasonable change orders for engineering work not anticipated at adoption of the Resolution) but does allow the Town to pursue payment to the Town by other parties of interested in the completion of this project .
