

RESOLUTION NO. 97-19

**A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE A DUPLEX GRINDER PUMP
FOR TEMPORARY USE IN CANDLEWOOD SUBDIVISION
FOR THE SUM OF \$8,100
WITH FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM WATER AND SEWER TAP FEES**

Whereas, an agreement was reached with the developers of Candlewood subdivision to remit \$30,000 to the Town for constructing whatever means necessary to accommodate wastewater from the subdivision;


Whereas, this agreement was reached with Candlewood in order to permanently eliminate a lift station and to use the force main already constructed by Candlewood developers from their low elevation point northward and across Duplex Road;

Whereas, houses are being constructed and will need sewage service before the gravity line is constructed; and

Whereas, bids were publicly requested and opened on March 14 and Water and Waste Equipment Company, Nashville, Tennessee was determined by staff to be the low bidder meeting the specification requirements.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that the sum of \$8,100 be drawn from water and sewer tap fees in order to procure a duplex self contained pump from Water and Waste Equipment Company, Nashville, Tennessee, and that the water department employees of Spring Hill will install this equipment in order to give temporary service to Candlewood subdivision until such time as the gravity line and return force main is installed. This is to be paid from water and sewer tap fees.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Spring Hill, Tennessee, this 17th day of March, 1997.
