

RESOLUTION NO. 97-35

**RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION (TDOT) TO DO A TRAFFIC STUDY IN
ORDER TO VERIFY A WARRANT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A
LEFT TURN LANE ON HIGHWAY 31 NORTH AT TOWN CENTER PARKWAY**

Whereas, traffic ingress and egress at the intersection of Town Center Parkway and Route 31 has reached a higher volume due to construction of the shopping mall, soon to be followed by other public service developments;

Whereas, this intersection has become a dangerous site for vehicles attempting to enter or exit via the northbound lane of Route 31;

Whereas, there is significant public demand to do something about this traffic condition as soon as possible; and

Whereas, the governing Board will need a turning lane warrant from the TDOT Traffic Engineering Division in order to see this project accomplished.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE that a request be submitted to the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Transportation for a traffic study be done for purposes of obtaining a warrant for a turning lane in the northbound lane of Route 31 at Town Center Parkway and that such study be done as soon as possible because the traffic conditions at this intersection are both dangerous and intolerable to the traveling public, and further that TDOT should perform this construction at the expense of the State of Tennessee.
