A RESOLUTION TO BID AND PURCHASE
A THERMAL IMAGING DEVICE
FOR USE IN LIFE SAVING
BY SPRING HILL VOLUNTEER FIREMEN,
MONIES TO BE DRAWN
FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CAPITOL PROJECTS FUNDS

Whereas, the volunteer fire department lacks a presently available means of rapidly seeing or finding a human body through dense smoke inside a building; and


Whereas, there now exists technology whereby any heat source can be detected through zero visibility;

Whereas, this technology also allows a firefighter to immediately detect the location of the "root" of the fire thereby allowing water or other suppressant to be placed directly onto the fire thereby stopping further property damage or loss;

Whereas, the cost justification for this expensive technology can be readily determined to be a one incident payback period whether life or property is at stake

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that the fire department is authorized to properly bid and purchase a thermal imaging device for ready availability to fire response teams and that funds, not to exceed \$22,100, shall be drawn from the fire department capitol projects funds
