
A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AS SURPLUS
A WATER DEPARTMENT 1988 CHEVROLET CAPRICE
AND TO PUBLICLY ADVERTISE
FOR "OFFERS TO PURCHASE" BIDS IN ORDER
TO REMOVE THE VEHICLE FROM THE TOWN'S FLEET INVENTORY

Whereas, the water department has a 1988 Chevrolet Caprice sedan in inventory that has been declared to be beyond practical use by the Town;

Whereas, this vehicle was worn out by the police department, then used by the water department for a number of years as a utility truck;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that the city administrator is hereby authorized to advertise the sale of a 1988 Chevrolet Caprice in the water department; thence take sealed bids and sell to the low bidder regardless of price offered.
