
A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH CLANTON PAVING COMPANY
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER LINE
FROM THE NEW SOUTH SIDE WATER STORAGE TANK
TO THE WATER MAIN IN STONEGATE SUBDIVISION
FOR THE SUM OF \$62,300.00,
FUNDS TO BE DRAWN FROM WATER ACCOUNTS
AS THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR MAY DETERMINE

Whereas, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen have determined that a south side water storage tank is necessary for the proper functioning of the Spring Hill water system and have approved such a tank; and

Whereas, in order that the storage tank may be placed in operation upon completion of construction, it is necessary for a line to be constructed from the tank to the water main located in the center road of Stonegate subdivision

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, that the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute an agreement with Clanton Paving Company, Shelbyville, Tennessee, for the sum of \$62,300.00 for construction of a water line, as designed and specified by Highers Koonce and Associates, Consulting Engineers, Nashville, Tennessee, from the south water storage tank to the water main in Stonegate subdivision with funds to be drawn from water accounts as the city administrator may determine to be most reasonable in contemplation of real and anticipated revenues.
