**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A ONE (1)  
TON DUMP TRUCK FOR THE STREETS DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the 1999-2000 Budget includes funds for the purchase of a one (1) ton dump truck for the Department of Streets and Public Works; and

**WHEREAS**, the pressing need for such a vehicle has been very clearly determined; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Tennessee has concluded their bid process and has made the list of low bidders and vehicles available to local governments.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the cost of the vehicle shall not exceed \$36,962.01.


